Organizer: **UNITOP Czech Republic** in cooperation with the Czech Ice Hockey Association
Venue: **LIBEREC**, regional capital of North Bohemia
Ice rings: **SVIJANSKA ARENA** see www.sportparkliberec.cz/sport/sportoviste/svijanska-arena

Number of participating teams = 10 teams: AUSTRIA, CZECHIA, FINLAND (Police Helsinki), FRANCE (Sentinelles), GERMANY, HUNGARY, RUSSIA (Dinamo and Police Moscow), SLOVENIA and SLOVAKIA

Play system in 2 (two) groups per 5 teams. Exact playing system will be still decided.

Matches guaranteed at least 5

Playing time in groups 2x 20 minutes net time

Playing time in the matches for position and in two semi-finals 2 x 20 minutes net time

Playing time in the small final and in FINAL 3x 20 minutes net time

The IIHF competitions rules will be respected

The referees will be delegated by the Czech Ice Hockey Association

The first medical aid unit will be present at every match

Prices/Awards: Each team will receive a special trophy according to its rank. Players of teams on the first three places will receive medals. During the farewell dinner, the organizer will also award prizes for the Fair play team, for the best scorer, the best goalkeeper and most valuable player.

Date of the official stay of the participating teams **18th – 23rd April 2017 !**

The necessary **local** transportation in Czech Republic will be provided by organizer's buses and cars: Airport/Hotel/Ice rinks. Distance from the Prague airport to LIBEREC is 130 km, about 2 hours.

Payments

Travelling expenses: Each team will cover its own travelling expenses to the Czech Republic
Tournament registration fee per team 500 EUR The respective invoice were sent to the billing addresses of teams.



Participation fee of each participant includes accommodation full board, the necessary local transportation, assistance of a team guide during the tournament, drinking regime and snacks during matches, etc. The respective invoice will be sent after receiving the definitive number of persons and the needed types of rooms. Participation fee has to be paid at the latest in March 3rd.

Hotel Babylon is distanced from the Arena sports complex by car 1,7 km, walking way is shorter, on foot about 10 min. For the participants living in Babylon will be offered special good prices for using regeneration in the water park and in the hotel's wellness.

Extended stay in Prague from Sunday 23th with the help of the organizing committee will be possible in the hotel Olsanka*** see www.hotelolsanka.cz near the city center of Prague (by tram to the Wenceslas Square 10min. only) with the hotel's special prices for our organizing committee.

Notes:

All players must be **full-time police officers !**

Participation is not possible for professional players playing in the last 12 months in NHL, KHL, etc., **VISA Delegations** which need a visa are requested to contact the host in time!,

Team guide will be assigned to each team for the duration of the tournament,

Potable water will be served at each meal and will be provided for teams during matches,

All teams shall wear **uniform sportswear** displaying the emblem of their national police sports union or their police club,

At least **one member of each team** has to wear **the police uniform** of their respective country at the opening ceremony,

The organizer shall not assume any liability in the event of accidents, theft and other events of damage or loss,

Insurance: the participating teams and each player are responsible for concluding their own travel and health insurance !
